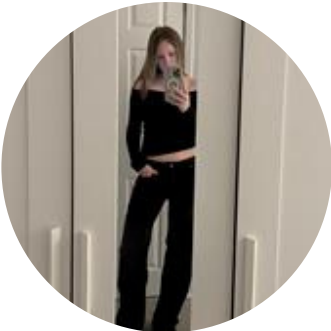


CARMEL 1 FIRST SESSION STAFF

I'm a Teva Specialist this year at camp! My favourite things to do are dance and crafts :) This is my first year at camp and I'm so excited to meet everyone!



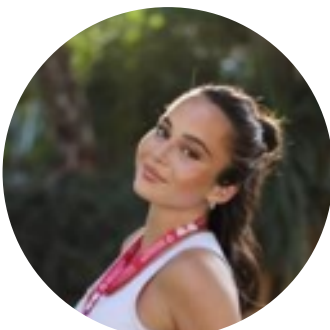
Karolina Krupa*

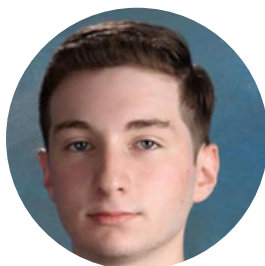
Zach Goldin
